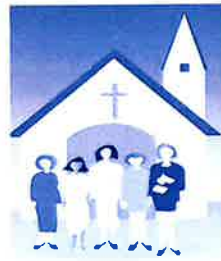

Financial Report for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025

Operating revenue was \$271,202, comprised primarily of \$122,528 for Offertory, \$99,999 for Donations and \$18,670 for Special Collections. One unusual item was \$15,008 for Insurance Proceeds that paid for storm damage expenditures made in fiscal year 2024. Operating expense was \$257,131, primarily comprised of \$105,682 for Priest & Rectory, \$46,737 for Lay Compensation and \$68,875 for Plant and Building. Included in expense were the following one-time capital related expenditures: \$2,550 for roofing repair, \$8,862 for Church heating, ventilation and air conditioning, \$4,444 for kitchen refrigerator, \$10,907 for parking lot paving, and \$1,024 for minor repairs.

Operating revenue exceeded operating expense by \$14,071.
